\*The oracle of 29:1, the latest dated prophecy in the Book of Ezekiel, fits here because it links the destruction of Egypt, which had just been prophesied, with the work of Nebuchadnezzar. When the long siege of Tyre ended in 574(3) B.C., the Babylonians were left without compensation for their labor for God. Therefore, in 571 B.C., God promised Egypt to Nebuchadnezzar.
