Preparation for His Death, Part 2

FRIDAY: THE DAY OF JESUS' DEATH (CONTINUED)

As the Passover feast drew to a close, Jesus instituted the most enduring memorial of all time: the Lord's Supper. (See Mt. 26:26–29; Mk. 14:22–25; Lk. 22:19, 20; Jn. 14:1—17:26.) [See *Life of Christ*, 2, pp. 401–403.]

- 2. What sort of figure of speech was Jesus using when He said, "This is My body" (Mt. 26:26; Mk. 14:22; Lk. 22:19)?
- 3. What did Jesus reveal about His death in Mt. 26:27, 28?
- 4. How does the peace of Christ differ from that of the world?
- 5. What forms of encouragement did Jesus offer His disciples in Jn. 14:1—16:33?
- 6. According to Christ, why was His leaving necessary?
- 7. On what conditions is Jesus' promise in 14:13 based?
- 8. What does praying in Jesus' name mean?
- 9. What did Jesus most likely mean when He said that the disciples would do greater works than He (Jn. 14:12)?
- 10. What works of the Godhead are attributed to the Holy Spirit (see Jn. 14:16, 17, 26; 15:26; 16:7–14)?

- 11. In what three senses did Jesus speak of returning to the apostles in John 14—16?
- 12. Into what two categories can most of the truths that Jesus spoke on the night before His death be grouped?
- 13. What are the three parts of Jesus' prayer in Jn. 17?
- 14. What does the Greek word translated "dwelling places" tell us about heaven?
- 15. When Christ said, "The Father is greater than I" (Jn. 14:28), what did He mean about His relationship to the Father?
- 16. Why would Jesus not make requests of the Father on His disciples' behalf, according to Jn. 16:26, 27?
- 17. What was Jesus predicting in Jn. 17:12b?

Jesus had a sleepless night. His disciples may have slumbered for an hour or so (Mt. 26:40), but He did not. During the first part of the night, Jesus' thoughts were not conducive to sleep; through the last part of the night, His enemies did not allow Him to sleep. (See Mt. 26:30, 36–46; Mk. 14:26, 32–42; Lk. 22:39–46; Jn. 18:1.)

- 19. Where was the Garden of Gethsemane, and how did it get its name?
- 20. Why were Peter, James, and John unable to stay awake to keep watch for Jesus (see Mk. 14:40; Lk. 22:45)?
