

JERUSALEM—Shown here is a section of the Western Wall of the temple complex. The stones were part of the foundation for the retaining wall that Herod had built around the Temple Mount. This is the only part of the temple complex that was not destroyed by the Romans in A.D. 70. Visible in the background is the Dome of the Rock, a mosque which now occupies the place where the magnificent temple once stood.
