



THE GARDEN OF GETHSEMANE—Located east of Jerusalem, across the Kidron Valley on the Mount of Olives, this garden spot was a favorite place for Jesus to pray and spend quiet time with His apostles (Jn. 18:1, 2). Matthew 26:30, 36 and Mark 14:26, 32 give the impression that the garden area itself was reached by passing through the olive orchard on the hillside (J. C.
