

OLD TESTAMENT PROPHECIES FULFILLED IN MATTHEW

- 1:22, 23 "Behold, the virgin shall be with child . . ." (see Is. 7:14).
- 2:5, 6 "' . . . For out of [Bethlehem] shall come forth a Ruler . . .'" (see Mic. 5:2).
- 2:15 "Out of Egypt I called My Son" (see Hos. 11:1).
- 2:17, 18 "A voice was heard in Ramah, weeping and great mourning . . ." (see Jer. 31:15).
- 2:23 "He shall be called a Nazarene."*
- 3:3 "The voice of one crying in the wilderness . . ." (see Is. 40:3).
- 4:14–16 " . . . Galilee of the Gentiles . . . saw a great Light . . ." (see Is. 9:1, 2).
- 8:17 "He Himself took our infirmities and carried away our diseases" (see Is. 53:4).
- 10:35, 36 "'For I came to set a man against his father, and a daughter against her mother . . .'" (see Mic. 7:6).
- 11:4, 5 "' . . . the blind receive sight and the lame walk . . . and the poor have the gospel preached to them'" (see Is. 29:18, 19; 35:5, 6; 61:1).
- 11:10 "'Behold, I send My messenger ahead of You . . .'" (see Mal. 3:1).
- 11:29 "'You will find rest for your souls'" (see Jer. 6:16).
- 12:17–21 " . . . I will put My Spirit upon [My Servant] . . ." (see Is. 42:1–4).
- 13:14, 15 "'You will keep on hearing, but will not understand . . .'" (see Is. 6:9, 10).
- 13:35 "I will open My mouth in parables . . ." (see Ps. 78:2).
- 15:7–9 "'This people honors Me with their lips, but their heart is far away from Me . . .'" (see Is. 29:13).
- 21:4, 5 " . . . Behold, your King is coming to you . . . on a donkey . . ." (see Zech. 9:9).
- 21:9 "'Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord'" (see Ps. 118:26).
- 21:13 "'My house shall be called a house of prayer"; but you are making it a robbers' den'" (see Is. 56:7; Jer. 7:11).
- 21:16 "'Out of the mouth of infants . . . You have prepared praise for Yourself'" (see Ps. 8:2).
- 21:42 "'The stone which the builders rejected, this became the chief corner stone . . .'" (see Ps. 118:22, 23).
- 26:31 "'I will strike down the shepherd, and the sheep of the flock shall be scattered'" (see Zech. 13:7).
- 27:9, 10 "And they took the thirty pieces of silver . . . and they gave them for the Potter's Field . . ." (see Zech. 11:12, 13; Jer. 19:1–13; 32:6–9).
