Chronology indicators begin with the Israelites' leaving Egypt the 15th day of the 1st month of the 1st year (Ex. 12:6, 18; Num. 33:3). They came to the wilderness of Sin the 15th day of the 2nd month (Ex. 16:1). Next, they arrived at Sinai the 15th day of the 3rd month of the 1st year (Ex. 19:1, 2). The tabernacle was erected the 1st day of the 1st month of the 2nd year (Ex. 40:17; see Num. 7:1, 10; 9:15). In Numbers 9:1–5, a historical account is given regarding the observance of the Passover after the tabernacle was erected. (See 9:10, 11 for the observance of the makeup Passover.) Six additional indicators are given in this chart.
