Offering (ch. 7)	The beginning of the presentation of offerings on “the day that the tabernacle was erected”	(1 <sup>st</sup> day, 1 <sup>st</sup> month, 2 <sup>nd</sup> year) (see Ex. 40:2, 17)	7:1
	The twelve days when the presentation of offerings for the dedication of the altar occurred	(1 <sup>st</sup> –12 <sup>th</sup> days, 1 <sup>st</sup> month, 2 <sup>nd</sup> year)	7:10–88
Passover (ch. 9)	The command to observe the Passover	(1 <sup>st</sup> day?), 1 <sup>st</sup> month, 2 <sup>nd</sup> year	9:1, 2
	The Passover observed for the second time <sup>1</sup>	14 <sup>th</sup> day, 1 <sup>st</sup> month, (2 <sup>nd</sup> year)	9:3, 5
	The Passover observance for those who were unclean earlier	14 <sup>th</sup> day, 2 <sup>nd</sup> month, (2 <sup>nd</sup> year)	9:10, 11
Cloud (ch. 9)	The cloud of guidance covered the tabernacle on “the day that the tabernacle was erected.”	(1 <sup>st</sup> day, 1 <sup>st</sup> month, 2 <sup>nd</sup> year) (see Ex. 40:2, 17, 34, 35)	9:15

Note: The use of parentheses for the time indicates facts that may be inferred but are not stated in the text of Numbers.

<sup>1</sup>The first Passover was observed the night before Israel left Egypt (Ex. 12).
